### **BOOTH FEES**

Booth sizes and fees (include hitch size in measurements):

- 10x10 = \$250
- 10x15 = \$325
- 10x20= \$375

### **PAYMENTS**

- All entries must include a \$25 nonrefundable entry fee.
- Checks may not be post-dated.
- Booth fees are due by May 1.
- Cash payments will not be accepted.

### ACCEPTANCE NOTIFICATION

- Status notification will be sent to all applicants on April 17.
- If accepted, you will also receive additional Health Department

### **BOOTH SET-UP**

- Booth set up and check-in will be Thursday, July 23 at 3:00 pm.
- You must check in at Hockaday booth before setting up your trailer or booth to confirm your booth position.
- The Hockaday Museum does not provide electrical cords or lights. Food vendors must bring their own.
- The Hockaday Museum asks all food vendors to be very careful of the grass.
   You may not pour liquids, including hot water or ice, on the grass.

### PLEASE NOTE:

To comply with the Health Department's regulations, food must be made on the premises or prepared in advance in a licensed kitchen. Commercial vendors must have a current license, which can be obtained from the Flathead County Health Department. Sanitarians from that agency will inspect booths during the fair. Your trailer or booth must be self-contained for washing dishes. Water on the park premises is limited. The Hockaday reserves the right to remove any food items or vendors that we feel are not safe for public consumption.
