How to Apply

CONNECTION 2009 program is open to all artists working and residing in Montana. Up to three artists or artist collaborations will be chosen to participate in the 2009 program. For consideration, please send the following information.

- 1. The original application, examples of your work and supporting materials
- 2. Four copies of the application and additional requested material
- 3. \$20 application fee

Please note: only one copy of your work examples and supporting materials are required with the original packet. If you are applying for group collaboration, all artists in the collaboration must submit a packet and explain what the collaboration is in the letter of intent.

Applications must be postmarked by February 28, 2009. Notification of accepted and declined applications will be sent by March 21, 2009. Late applications will not be considered.
